Eva Longoria and Antonio Banderas, stars of the Latino "Alma" Awards

Actress Jessica Alba, who showed off her figure less than three weeks after giving birth to her second daughter, received the best actress award for *Machete*



For yet another year **Eva Longoria** was the perfect hostess of the **Alma Award ceremony**, which pays tribute to the achievements of Latinos in show business. The actress changed dresses on several occasions and showed her most playful side on the stage of the Santa Monica Civic Auditorium (Los Angeles) accompanied by comedian George López.

The big winners of the ceremony, which is set to air on the 16th on US channel NBC, were **Antonio Banderas** and **Jessica Alba**. The actor from Málaga, who won the best actor award for his work in the Woody Allen film *You Will Meet a Tall Dark Stranger*, addressed his nephew from the stage, present at the event along with wife **Melanie Griffith**, prompting him to always remember his "Hispanic" identity. "I wish to dedicate this award to my nephew Javi", said Banderas, explaining that he had come to live with him in Los Angeles to pursue his dream of becoming an actor, something he had coveted ever since seeing Banderas star in the popular Zorro saga.





The show-stopper was provided by **Gloria Estefan** and the sound of her *Wepa*, the first single from her next album "Miss Little Havana2 due for release on September 27, and marking her return to dance music in the English language. Among the guests who did not want to miss out on the evening of tribute to Latino film, television and music was Spanish actor **Miguel Ángel Muñoz**, who surprised photographers upon his arrival to the ceremony by posing with Princess **Theodora of Greece**, who has just finished shooting her first Hollywood film, *Crimson Tear*.
